

Syllabus information from Center for Student Success:

“Tutors and additional free services for academic success can be accessed by calling (517) 796-8415 or by stopping by the Center for Student Success, Bert Walker Hall Room 123. Faculty and tutors in the CSS will help you with writing, study skills, test anxiety, math, and reading.”

“Students requiring special assistance (including those affected by the Americans with Disabilities Act) should contact the Center for Student Success. This is the first step in acquiring the appropriate accommodations to facilitate your learning.”

What if I think a student has some sort of learning or physical disability?

Contact Marian Burlingham, (517) 796-8415. When you go over the syllabus, make the general statement that:

“Students who have any sort of situation, such as hearing loss, visual impairment, or any sort of learning disability, should contact the Center for Student Success right away to find out what assistance is available”.

Avoid asking individual students directly, but certainly make the general statement that help is available, and the sooner they get help, the better.
