Tips for Students –

Successfully Completing The Early Childhood Development and Education Program

- ⇒ Decide what you are trying to accomplish: professional development through a course, a CDA or other certificate, an Associate degree, transfer to a four-year school or all.
- ⇒ Talk with a Student Services Coordinator or the Program Coordinator before registering each semester. If you take a few minutes to stop in, call or e-mail, you can help make sure you are enrolling in the best selection of courses to keep you on track towards graduation or completion.
- ⇒ Early Childhood classes rotate around all three counties over a year or two (ECE 143, 150, 151 and 152 are the exception to this - they are offered on Main Campus only.) If you see a class on the schedule now, you can expect it to only show up in the other counties during the next two semesters or so.
- ⇒ Early Childhood courses are usually offered in the evening or Saturday mornings.
- ⇒ Watch for the course(s) you want to take when each new semester schedule comes out.
- ⇒ Enroll as soon as you can (waiting may mean driving to a farther campus or rethinking your completion plan.)
- ⇒ Associate degree General Education requirements for English, mathematics, science, social studies, humanities, and health/physical fitness are offered every semester in all three counties.
- ⇒ Talk with a Student Services Coordinator or the Program Coordinator, read the JCC catalog or check on-line at www.jccmi.edu for detailed course descriptions, degree requirements and other program information and helpful resources.
