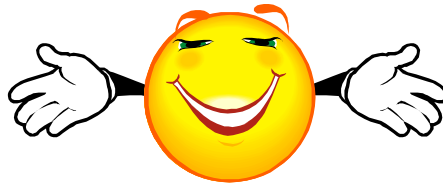

TEACHER EDUCATION **Checklist for Advising**
for YOU!



Should I take:
EDU 100 Pre-Teaching Pathway OR EDU 221-Exploring Teaching?

The JCC Teacher Education program is designed for student success. Please read the following questions to help you decide what course would be best for you.

1. Have you *recently* taken ENG 131 with a B or better? And are you comfortable with technology?
2. Have you had more than 20 hours serving in a public school? Coaching? Sunday school?
3. Do you feel you can commit to at least 2 hours a week of participation in an area K-12 classroom?
4. Are you feeling “fairly” sure about becoming a teacher or working with K-12 students?
5. Is your college GPA at least a 2.5?

If you answered **YES** to most of the above, especially #1, you **may** be ready for EDU 221.

1. Do you think you might you be interested in teaching but you are not quite sure?
2. You have not taken ENG 131.
3. Do you have limited or NO experience in K-12 classrooms?
4. Can you commit to approximately 1 hour a week most of the semester participating in an area K-12 classroom?
5. Is your GPA lower than 2.5?

If you answered **yes** to most of the above you **are** ready for EDU 100.
