Jackson Community College is pleased to request submissions for the 2005-2006 *Trillium*, the literary and art journal published annually by the Language, Literature and Arts Department. Entries may include poems, short stories, creative non-fiction, plays, photographs, and art work.

Eligibility: The contest is open to all JCC STUDENTS enrolled Fall 2005, Winter 2006, or plan to enroll Spring 2006.

Deadline: Entries must be in the Language, Literature and Arts Department on main campus (Bert Walker Hall, Room 233) by Monday, November 1, 2006.

Requirements: Submissions are limited to five per person.

Submissions must be typed and doubled-spaced on 8 1/2 X 11 paper or preferable submitted on a 3 1/2 computer disc saved in Microsoft Word format or rich text format (RTF).

Each entry must include the name of the author or artist, address, telephone number, and e-mail address, if possible. Submit *Trillium* entries, so be considered for JCC's *Harriet L. Stolorow* Writing award, to Deb Davies. Submit essay entries for the *Lyman L. Fink Excellence in Writing* award to Syd Thomas.

JCC values writing and art that communicates distinctly in an authentic voice. We value work that shows control of artistic technique and a spirit of exploration and discovery. We want our journal to reflect the diversity of our students' lives.
