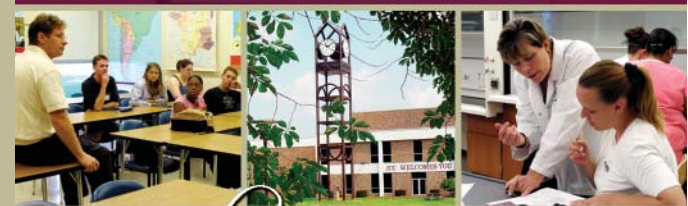

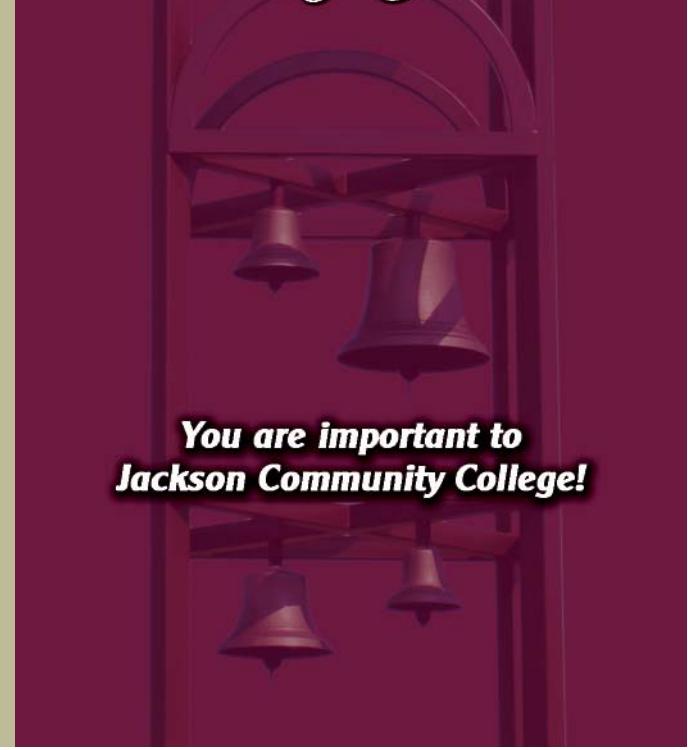

Annual campaign gifts are designated for current use -- to be used where the need is the greatest. Annual giving provides support for academic programs, student scholarships, and resources that are vital in today's educational climate. Your annual gift supports JCC's Excellence in Education Fund, which provides unrestricted support to the College. In addition, last year designated gifts helped the Foundation award \$143,000 in scholarship money to assist 150 students in fulfilling their dreams.

Why doesn't the College charge enough to cover operating costs?

If tuition were increased to cover the actual cost of all programs, many could not afford to attend. Remaining accessible to our community leads us to seek alternative means of funding operations so that students don't bear the full burden through higher tuition.

What are the levels of giving?

- Wickwire Circle (\$200 to \$499)
- Contributor (\$25 to \$199)
