Certificate**



*Arts & Communications Pathway*

This 30-hour program prepares students through coursework and hands-on-experience for work in technical theater. The certificate includes a range of topics designed to give students experience in basic skills and knowledge to work behind the scenes in theatre or other venues.

Typical job opportunities are exhibit/display designer, lighting designer, lighting operator, scene painter, stage/set designer, stage manager, and visual/sound effects. This program also consists of the foundational courses needed for an associate degree.
