

## Java Warning – Security Concern Pop-up

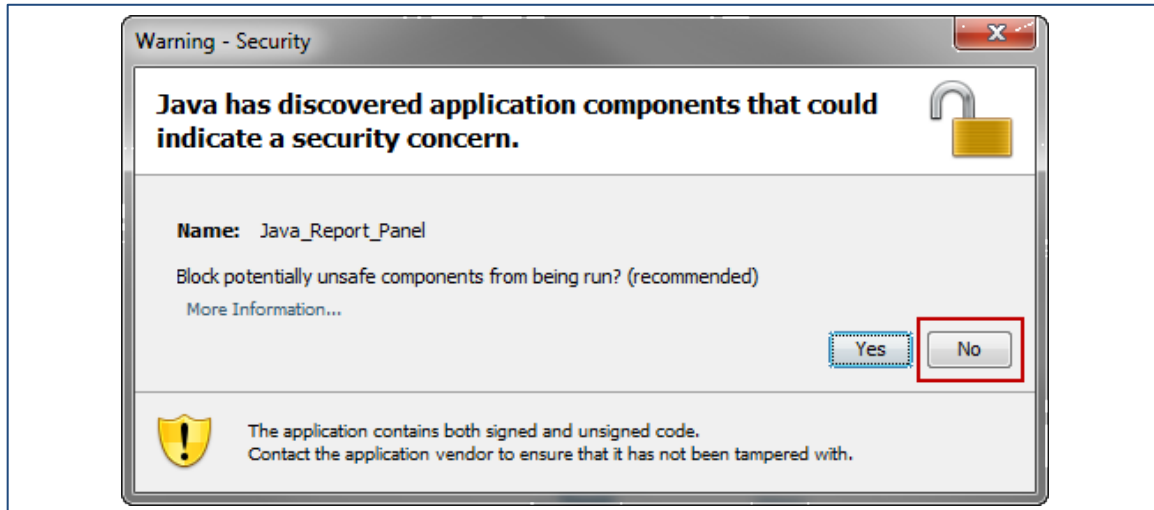

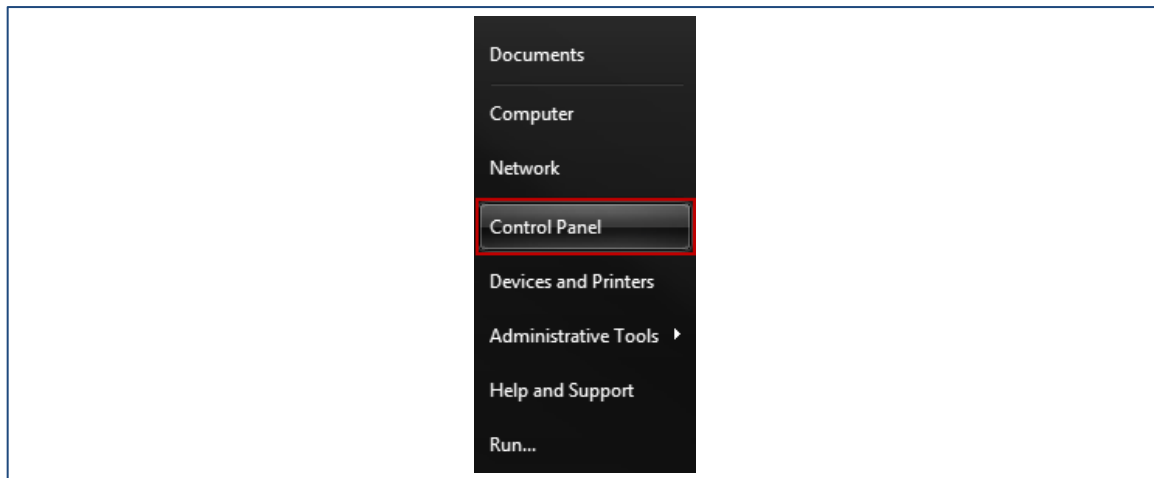

When you begin to modify a Web Intelligence report, you may be prompted with a **Warning – Security** window just like the image below. This message is trying to warn you of potentially unsafe components that could run in the background. This is similar to enabling Macro's in Excel. Even though it recommends saying yes to block components you will want to **answer 'No'**.

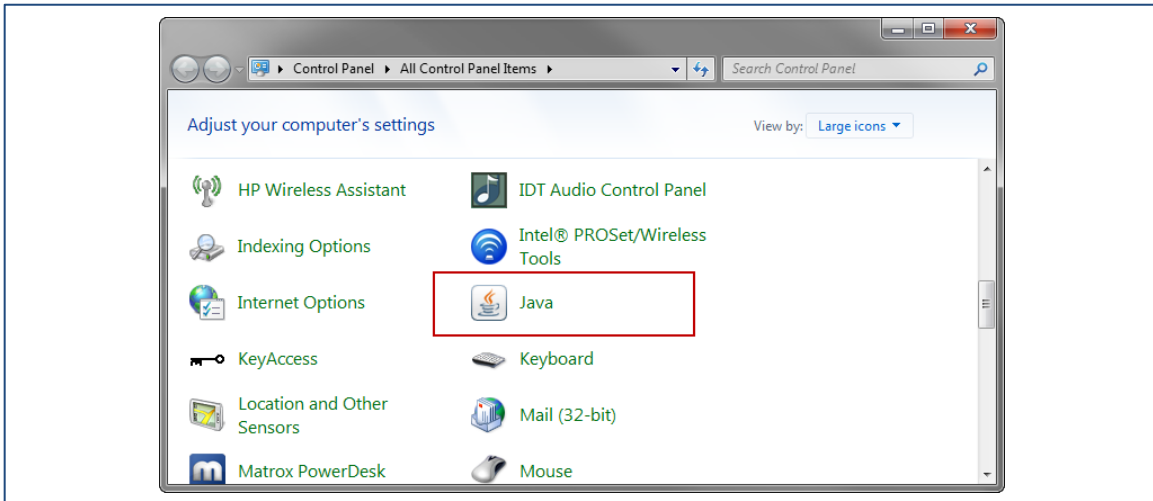


To ensure that you will not receive these messages, simply follow the steps below:

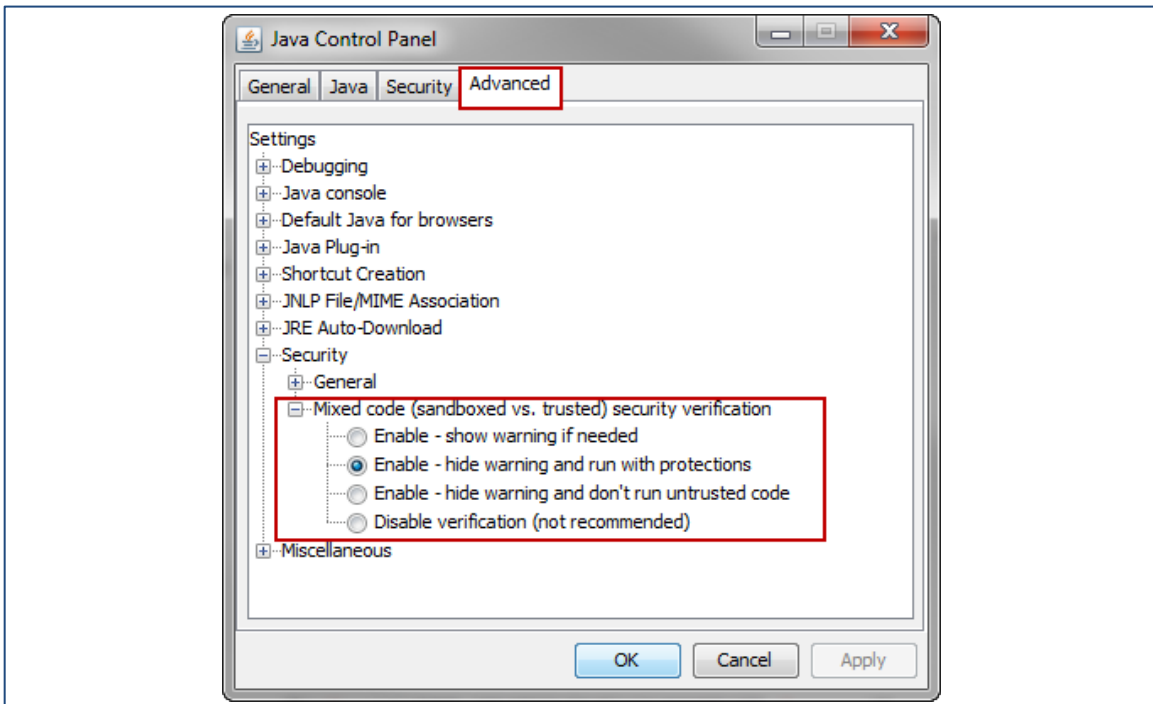
**Step 1:** Click the **Start** button on the Windows task bar and then click on **Control Panel** in the start menu.



**Step 2:** In the Control Panel, **Click on Java** to open the Java Control Panel window.



**Step3:** Choose the **Advanced Tab** and then expand **Security > Mixed code (sandboxed vs. trusted) security verification**.



**Step 4:** Click on the **Enable – hide warning and run with protections** radio button and then click **Apply** and **OK**.
