Administrative Policy

Policy Summary: Jackson College reserves the right to withhold student record information until financial obligations are cleared.

Policy Statement:

- Jackson College may withhold diplomas and other non-academic records for students with a prior balance of less than \$100 until all financial obligations are cleared. However, student transcripts will not be withheld due to unpaid balances.
- Jackson College may restrict further registration activity for students with a prior balance greater than \$100 until all financial obligations are cleared.
- Financial obligations may result from unpaid tuition, housing expenses, student fees, library fees, and other charges.
- The Jackson College Business Office authorizes placing a hold on a student's non-academic records and registration activity and authorizes the release of the hold when the obligation has been cleared.
