## Policy Summary:

Jackson College (JC) is committed to promoting students' behavioral health and creating a safe learning environment for all students. The College recognizes the importance of behavioral health to academic success and, as such, has developed a behavioral health referral policy to connect students to on-and off-campus resources.

## Scope:

This policy applies to all students seeking support and services that are beyond the scope of the College's capacity to provide.

### **Policy Statement:**

JC shall establish and maintain appropriate behavioral health referral procedures, including on-campus resources and community mental health agencies, for potentially at-risk students.

The Associate Dean, Student Services/designee will make appropriate referrals. For students experiencing personal issues that cannot be addressed in CSS, a referral to the JC Oasis Center will be made. If the Oasis Center is closed, please contact Family Service and Children's Aid at 517-787-7920 for their after-hours answering service. Lifeways Community Mental Health also has a crisis hotline that can be utilized 24hrs/day and can be reached at (800) 284-8288. In the event a student appears to be posing immediate danger to themselves or others, 911 and our JC Security team will be alerted.

### **Definitions:**

<u>Community Mental Health Agencies (CMHA)</u> - Agencies in the College's tri-county service area (Jackson, Lenawee, and Hillsdale) that offer mental health services have been identified.

Offered services may be free or at a cost to the student.
