## **Policy Summary:**

The purpose of this policy is to provide direction to Jackson College's (JC) Safety & Security personnel and Contract Security Services in the enforcement of laws, ordinances and policies on properties owned, operated or controlled by JC.

## **Policy Statement:**

This policy is to provide guidance for most incidents, but can in no way list or define every situation Safety & Security personnel may find themselves in. The intervention of Safety & Security Personnel may be required to protect students, staff and visitors to the campuses of JC.

Legal Justification - Act 309 of 2006; Self-Defense Act (Excerpt)

- a. 780.972 Use of deadly force by individual not engaged in commission of crime; conditions.
- b. Sec. 2.
- c. (1) An individual who has not or is not engaged in the commission of a crime at the time he or she uses deadly force may use deadly force against another individual anywhere he or she has the legal right to be with no duty to retreat if either of the following applies:
- d. (a) The individual honestly and reasonably believes that the use of deadly force is necessary to prevent the imminent death of or imminent great bodily harm to himself or herself or to another individual.
- e. (b) The individual honestly and reasonably believes that the use of deadly force is necessary to prevent the imminent sexual assault of himself or herself or of another individual.

Due to the sensitive nature of this information, the procedures are "classified" and available in the safety and security office upon request from administration.
