Policy Summary:

This policy established the minimum grading point average necessary, in all courses, to be considered as satisfying certificate and/or degree requirements.

Policy Statement:

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 grade in all pre-requisites and all courses contributing to an earned certificate or degree. Some programs have additional grade and course requirements that may be higher than the standard 2.0 grade. Students should follow the guide sheet for their program and meet with a student success navigator for complete information. Students can have their registrations terminated if they are not successful in the prerequisite for the course. Important: only courses with a 2.0 or better will transfer to most four-year colleges and universities.

Additionally, any college course that is below the 100 level will not count or be calculated towards a student’s Jackson College degree or certificate.
