Policy Summary: Course Auditing

Jackson College recognizes that students may wish to register for a course without credit or grade. Students are allowed to choose “audit” as a course registration option. This policy sets the terms and conditions for auditing courses.

Policy Statement

Jackson College has the option, when a student’s wish to attend a course without receiving a grade or credit is presented, to offer an audit in course registration. The audit option must be selected at registration or before the end of the course section add/drop period. Tuition and fees for audit classes are the same as graded and credit-bearing courses.

The student’s transcript will reflect the audited courses with a mark of “Y”. The “Y” is not calculated into the student’s cumulative grade point average.

A student may request instructor permission for a change from audit to credit up to the last day of the withdrawal period for the course section. Students may not change a graded course to an audit after the add/drop period and may not use financial aid for audited courses.
