## **Articulation Agreement between Cleary University and Jackson College**

### I. Agreement in Principle

Cleary University (hereinafter referred to as "Cleary") and Jackson College (hereinafter referred to as "Jackson") agree to cooperate regarding the articulation of credit for students who have completed an associate degree. Further, both parties agree that this experience should be one that maximizes utilization of credits and minimizes duplication of coursework and administrative obstacles. Therefore, Cleary and Jackson enter into the articulation agreement for students who complete the courses and degrees as noted in the agreement. Both parties agree that additional transfer guides may be added under this agreement with the mutual written concurrence of both parties. Both parties enter into this agreement as cooperating equal partners who shall maintain the integrity of their separate programs.

### II. Agreement on Program Specifics

### Transfer guides

Cleary and Jackson agree that any student who has completed the minimum requirements for an associate' degree or the equivalent thereof at Jackson may transfer the course credits to a Cleary bachelor's degree following the Transfer Guide(s) included in Appendix A.

#### Tuition and fees

Cleary and Jackson agree that Jackson students may qualify for scholarships reserved for transfer students at Cleary University, and that the application fee shall be waived for students under this agreement. The student shall be responsible for applicable Cleary tuition and fees once enrolled at Cleary.

#### Dual enrollment

Cleary and Jackson agree that Jackson students who are in good academic standing shall be automatically admitted to Cleary after completing an application form and providing documentation to meet Cleary admission requirements. A minimum Jackson cumulative GPA of 2.0 (4.0 scale) is required. ### Transfer Credit Requirement

This agreement allows transfer of Jackson coursework to Cleary that normally applies toward a Jackson associate degree. In addition to the transfer of specific courses with Cleary equivalencies, Jackson coursework that does not align with particular Cleary course or defined equivalencies may be considered toward meeting Cleary general education and/or elective requirements. All credits included on the attached transfer guides will apply toward the applicable Cleary major. Up to 90 semester credits that meet program requirements may be transferred to Cleary in alignment with Cleary's residency requirement policy.

## III. Agreement on Communication and Promotion

To ensure the success of this agreement, both parties agree to identify this agreement in their catalog, websites, publications and other communication or promotion venues. Both parties agree that the other may use logos or identification marks provided they abide by the identity standards of that party.

Jackson academic advisors will consult with Jackson students, providing them with information needed to matriculate into the Cleary program. Jackson will assist Cleary staff with an appropriate process for accessing student information or promoting the Cleary program on the Jackson campus or in classrooms. Cleary agrees to consult with Jackson before coming onto the campus or going into classrooms, as appropriate.

Cleary will supply Jackson with transfer guides and other print materials to facilitate the student advising and promotion process.

# IV. Agreement on Maintenance and Review Procedures

At least one staff or faculty member for each institution shall be appointed to act as agents and point of contact in the implementation of this agreement, to speak on behalf of the institution, and to communicate changes to the respective faculty and staff at Jackson and Cleary. Responsibility for oversight of this agreement rests with the Provost and Executive Vice President at Cleary and with the New Student Engagement Recruitment & Transfer Strategist at Jackson. Jackson and Cleary representatives agree to communicate program changes as they arise and if they impact the agreement. Otherwise, the agreement shall be reviewed every three years. If this agreement is discontinued, both parties agree that students in the process of matriculating or completing the degree at Jackson or Cleary shall be able to complete their respective program under the terms of this agreement.



### This agreement is effective as of April 1, 2025 until April 1, 2028.

#### **Transfer Guide**

Business Administrations Associate in Arts (BUAD.AA) degree from Jackson College to a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) in Business Management at Cleary University (in any Major Concentration)

Jackson students who complete an the BUAD.AA degree, complete the courses outlined in this transfer guide with a grade of "C" or better, and satisfy Cleary's admissions requirements will be accepted in alignment with this articulation agreement. Students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours in residency at Cleary to complete the BBA in Business Management degree.

Cleary agrees to accept a block of 30 general education credit hours in alignment with the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) see the chart below.
