- **Fall to winter persistence** – goal/actual/variance
Fall to fall retention - goal/actual/variance
 - *Goal for Fall to Winter persistence is 90%*
 - *Goal for Fall to Fall retention is 80%*
 - Is there a difference between the term retention and persistence?
 - Who should be included in the cohort? Do we exclude any groups of students?
 - At what point in time are we looking at this report?
- **Completion rates (Graduation)**- goal/actual/variance
 - *Goal Completion Rate is 70%*
 - Leadership would like to include “Credentials of industry recognized value” what degrees does this include?
 - Do we include transfer student as completers?
- **Billing Contact hours** – goal/actual/variance
 - This item will be similar to the former weekly enrollment Report.
 - Goals are set on a semester basis.
- **Course Completion rate**
 - Leadership asked to exclude developmental courses.
 - Successful completers are those with a 2.0 or higher or a P grade.
 - Need to exclude non-graded courses.
 - Should W/WX/I count as non-completion or be listed in a separate column?
