3. Do not owe money back on a federal student grant or have made satisfactory arrangements to repay it,
4. Will notify your school if you default on a federal student loan and
5. Will not receive a Federal Pell Grant for more than one school for the same period of time.

If you are the parent, or the student, by signing this form you agree, if asked, to provide information that will verify the accuracy of your completed FAFSA. This information may include your U.S. income tax return transcripts. Also, you certify that you understand that **the Secretary of Education has the authority to verify information reported on the FAFSA with the Internal Revenue Service and other Federal agencies.** If you purposely give false or misleading information, you may be fined \$20,000, sent to prison, or both.
