



TITLE IX: FERPA RELEASE FOR INVESTIGATION

(For Complainant)

Complaints filed by students are generally considered education records under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). With a few exceptions, education records protected by FERPA cannot be disclosed without student consent. By signing this form, I, _____, provide consent under FERPA for the appropriate Jackson College personnel to disclose and use the information in the complaint I filed for the purpose of investigating the allegations contained within my complaint and the circumstances surrounding my complaint.

I understand that (1) I have the right to not consent to the release of my education records; (2) I have the right to access such records upon request; and (3) this release shall remain in effect unless revoked by me in writing delivered to the Title IX Coordinator. If I do revoke this consent, the revocation shall not affect disclosures previously made by Jackson College while conducting the investigation of my complaint prior to receipt of the written revocation. I further understand that revoking or not providing this release may affect Jackson College's ability to make a meaningful investigation of my complaint.
