

Leadership Council Prior Meeting Review 01.19.22

First team reviewed prior meeting minutes and they were approved with two small changes. Work products was reviewed briefly and needs to be updated.

Dr. Rose and David Buck from CampusWorks joined us briefly but stepped out for 15 minutes while we interviewed Susan Lafayette who will serve as the Project Manager for the LMS System. Susan has five+ years of experience managing the development and e-learning courses and training modules. The team was happy with Susan who will be coming to campus for two weeks, beginning Monday (January 31, and staying in a tiny home). VP Frew will be putting together a list of questions/projects/concerns they would like to have addressed with his staff in those two weeks and will send those to Susan prior to her arrival. Susan will align with her list of first steps in her project management of similar projects.

Dr. Wayne Rose and David Buck from CampusWorks presented results of survey work they have been conducting which included IT employee's perception of themselves and their work, what others on campus have said, what CampusWorks has observed, as well as national benchmarking data. Conversations were had about next steps.
