## Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree at Jackson College to a Bachelor of Science in Public Health, B.S. at Western Michigan University

JC students who complete an associate degree, complete the courses outlined in the guide sheet with a grade of a "C" or better, and satisfy WMU's admissions requirements will be accepted into the articulation agreement.

Under this agreement, WMU will accept 60 credit hours and require a minimum of 62 credit hours to be completed in courses offered by WMU. This allows students to utilize the credit hours earned at JC and have those applied toward their bachelor's degree.
